- 1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-10-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating
2 to authorizing the Office of Miners', Health, Safety, and Training to promulgate a legislative
3 rule relating to rules governing the certification, recertification, and training of EMT-miners
4 and the certification of EMT-M instructors.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

**ARTICLE 10. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE TO
PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

§64-10-1. Office of Mine's Health, Safety and Training.

- 1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 25, 2019, authorized under the
2 authority of §22A-10-3 of this code, relating to the Office of Miner's Health, Safety and Training
3 (rules governing the certification, recertification and training of EMT-miners and the certification
4 of EMT-M instructors, [56 CSR 22](#)), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Office of Miner's Health, Safety and Training to promulgate a legislative rule relating to rules governing the certification, recertification, and training of EMT-miners and the certification of EMT-M instructors.
