1 A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new section,
2 designated §7-1-3tt, relating to requiring posting of the Ten Commandments in every
3 courthouse.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 3. COUNTY PROPERTY.

§7-1-3tt. Duty to post Ten Commandments in every courthouse.

1 In addition to all other powers and duties now conferred by law upon county commissions,
2 each commission is hereby required to post the Ten Commandments in its county courthouse.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to require posting of the Ten Commandments in each courthouse.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from a heading or the present law and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
