## Senate Bill 525

BY SENATORS TARR AND SWOPE

[Introduced January 17, 2020; referred to the Committee on Economic Development; and

then to the Committee on Government Organization]

- A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new section,
  designated §5B-1-9, relating to requiring the Secretary of Commerce to present certain
  information to the Joint Committee on Government and Finance during the 2020 legislative
- 4 interim sessions.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

#### ARTICLE 1. DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE.

#### §5B-1-9. Additional duties of the secretary.

- 1 The Secretary of Commerce shall present to the Joint Committee on Government and
- 2 Finance during the 2020 legislative interim sessions:
- 3 (1) A list of the foremost challenges for being competitive in attracting businesses to West
- 4 <u>Virginia.</u>
- 5 (2) Draft legislation necessary to affect a minimum level of funding relating to subdivision

#### 6 (1) of this section, that includes:

- 7 (A) Site certification funding;
- 8 (B) Closing funding; and
- 9 (C) Any other considerations.
- 10 (3) A vision and Mission Statement for the West Virginia Development Office.
- 11 (4) A list of what the West Virginia Development Office is doing now that should be a
- 12 <u>function of government.</u>
- 13 (5) A list of what the West Virginia Development Office is doing now that should be done
- 14 by private enterprise.
- 15 (6) A list of what the West Virginia Development Office is mandated to do now that should
- 16 <u>not be a function of the West Virginia Development office.</u>
- 17 (7) A plan for the Legislature's consideration of a public-private structure to replace the
- 18 current West Virginia Development Office that comprehensively considers the items identified in
- 19 <u>subdivisions (1) through (6) of this section, and a date certain that the office can be transitioned</u>

#### 20 to a public-private structure should legislation be passed to make it possible in the 2021 legislative

#### 21 <u>session.</u>

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to require the Secretary of Commerce to present certain information to the Joint Committee on Government and Finance during the 2020 legislative interim sessions.
