1 A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new section,  
2 designated §15A-5-10, relating to the waiver of all penalties, costs, assessments,  
3 forfeitures, fines, and fees associated with criminal convictions for persons who  
4 successfully complete the Getting Over Addicted Lifestyles Successfully Program in jail  
5 for the purpose of obtaining a driver's license.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

**ARTICLE 5. BUREAU OF PRISONS AND JAILS.**

**§15A-5-10. Waiver of fines and fees for successfully completing the GOALS Program.**

1 Notwithstanding any provision of this code to the contrary, any individual committed to the  
2 custody of the Commissioner of the Division of Corrections and Rehabilitation who successfully  
3 completes the Getting Over Addictive Lifestyles Successfully Program shall have all monetary  
4 penalties, costs, assessments, forfeitures, fines, and fees associated with his or her criminal  
5 convictions waived for the purposes of obtaining a driver's license. The provisions of this waiver  
6 do not apply to any restitution owed. Unpaid restitution shall not be a bar to the issuance or  
7 reissuance of the individual's driver's license.
