1 A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new section,
2 designated §20-5-20, relating to providing a ten percent discount to West Virginia
3 residents for lodging, camping and other recreational activities at state parks and forests.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 5. PARKS AND RECREATION.

§20-5-20. Discounts for West Virginia residents.

1 The director shall provide to West Virginia residents a ten percent reduction in fees at all
2 state parks and forests for lodging, campsite rental and other recreational activities. The director
3 shall propose rules for legislative approval in accordance with the provisions of §29A-3-1 et seq.
4 of this code setting forth standards for documentation of proof of residency.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to provide a ten percent discount to West Virginia residents for lodging, camping and other recreation activities at state parks and forests.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from a heading or the present law and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
