A BILL to repeal §55-9-1, §55-9-2, and §55-9-3 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, all relating to repealing antiquated provisions relating to void gaming contracts, recovery

and loss of money in gaming, and recovery of gaming losses by bill in equity.

§1 Repeal of article relating to unlawful gaming contracts

5 That §55-9-1, §55-9-2, and §55-9-3 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, are

6 repealed.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to repeal §55-9-1, §55-9-2, and §55-9-3 of the Code of West Virginia to remove antiquated provisions of the code relating to gaming activities.
