1 AN ACT making a supplementary appropriation of federal funds out of the Treasury from the  
2 balance of federal moneys remaining unappropriated for the fiscal year ending June 30,  
3 2022, to the Department of Health and Human Resources, Division of Health – Substance  
4 Abuse Prevention and Treatment, fund 8793, fiscal year 2022, organization 0506; to the  
5 Department of Health and Human Resources, Division of Health – Community Mental  
6 Health Services, fund 8794, fiscal year 2022, organization 0506; to Department of Health  
7 and Human Resources, Division of Human Services - Energy Assistance, fund 8755, fiscal  
8 year 2022, organization 0511; to the Department of Health and Human Resources,  
9 Division of Human Services – Temporary Assistance for Needy Families, fund 8816, fiscal  
10 year 2022, organization 0511; and to the Department of Health and Human Resources,  
11 Division of Human Services – Child Care and Development, fund 8817, fiscal year 2022,  
12 organization 0511, by supplementing and amending the appropriations for the fiscal year  
13 ending June 30, 2022.

14 Whereas, The Governor has established the availability of federal funds for expenditure  
15 in the fiscal year ending June 30, 2022, which are hereby appropriated by the terms of this  
16 supplementary appropriation bill; therefore
