- 3 relating to private club licensing.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 7. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE TO PROMULGATE

LEGISLATIVE RULES.

§64-7-1. Alcohol Beverage Control Commission.

The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 24, 2020, authorized under the authority of §60-7-10 of this code, modified by the Alcohol Beverage Control Commission to meet the objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and refiled in the State Register on November 18, 2020, relating to the Alcohol Beverage Control Commission (private club licensing, 175 CSR 02), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Alcohol Beverage Control Commission to promulgate a legislative rule relating to private club licensing.

This section is new; therefore, strike-throughs and underscoring have been omitted.
