1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-7-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating  
2 to authorizing the Alcohol Beverage Control Commission to promulgate a legislative rule  
3 relating to private club licensing.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

**ARTICLE 7. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE TO PROMULGATE  
LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

**§64-7-1. Alcohol Beverage Control Commission.**

1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 24, 2020, authorized under the  
2 authority of §60-7-10 of this code, modified by the Alcohol Beverage Control Commission to meet  
3 the objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and refiled in the State Register  
4 on November 18, 2020, relating to the Alcohol Beverage Control Commission (private club  
5 licensing, [175 CSR 02](#)), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Alcohol Beverage Control Commission to promulgate a legislative rule relating to private club licensing.

This section is new; therefore, strike-throughs and underscoring have been omitted.
