1 A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new section,  
2 designated §17A-3-15a, relating to disabled veterans and veterans who received the  
3 Purple Heart medal may park free at parking spaces controlled by this state or any political  
4 subdivision thereof.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

**ARTICLE 3. ORIGINAL AND RENEWAL OF REGISTRATION; ISSUANCE OF  
CERTIFICATES OF TITLE.**

**§17A-3-15a. Free parking for disabled veterans and veterans awarded the Purple Heart  
medal.**

1 Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, any person who is a disabled veteran  
2 of the United States armed forces or who is a recipient of the Purple Heart medal may park at any  
3 state or political subdivision-controlled paid public parking space in this state without being  
4 required to provide any remuneration for such parking spaces: *Provided*, That an appropriate  
5 designation must appear on the person's registration plate under the provisions of §17A-3-14 of  
6 this code demonstrating that the person is a disabled veteran or is the recipient of the Purple  
7 Heart medal.
