- 1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-3-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating
- 2 to authorizing the Department of Environmental Protection to promulgate a legislative rule
- 3 relating to the voluntary remediation and redevelopment rule.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 3. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.

§64-3-1. Department of Environmental Protection.

- 1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on August 25, 2020, authorized under the
- 2 authority of §22-22-3 of this code, modified by the Department of Environmental Protection to
- 3 meet the objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and refiled in the State
- 4 Register on December 11, 2020, relating to the Department of Environmental Protection
- 5 (voluntary remediation and redevelopment rule, 60 CSR 03), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Department of Environmental Protection to promulgate a legislative rule relating to the voluntary remediation and redevelopment rule.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from a heading or the present law and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
