- 1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-7-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating
- 2 to authorizing the Insurance Commissioner to promulgate a legislative rule relating to
- 3 credit for reinsurance.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

## ARTICLE 7. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.

#### §64-7-1. Insurance Commissioner.

- 1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 27, 2020, authorized under the
- 2 authority of §33-2-10 of this code, modified by the Insurance Commissioner to meet the objections
- 3 of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and refiled in the State Register on September
- 4 30, 2020, relating to the Insurance Commissioner (credit for reinsurance, 114 CSR 40), is
- 5 authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Insurance Commissioner to promulgate a legislative rule relating to credit for reinsurance.
