## **Senate Bill 176**

1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-7-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating  
2 to authorizing the State Tax Department to promulgate a legislative rule relating to high-  
3 wage growth business tax credit.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

**ARTICLE 7. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE TO PROMULGATE  
LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

**§64-7-1. State Tax Department.**

1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 29, 2020, authorized under the  
2 authority of §11-10-5 of this code, modified by the State Tax Department to meet the objections  
3 of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and refiled in the State Register on October 5,  
4 2020, relating to the State Tax Department (high-wage growth business tax credit, [110 CSR 13II](#)),  
5 is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the State Tax Department to promulgate a legislative rule relating to high-wage growth business tax credit.

This section is new; therefore, strike-throughs and underscoring have been omitted.
