## **Senate Bill 190**

1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-9-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating  
 2 to authorizing the Board of Funeral Service Examiners to promulgate a legislative rule  
 3 relating to crematory requirements.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

**ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS AGENCIES AND BOARDS  
 TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

**§64-9-1. Board of Funeral Service Examiners.**

1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on August 24, 2020, authorized under the  
 2 authority of §30-6-6 of this code, modified by the Board of Funeral Service Examiners to meet the  
 3 objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and refiled in the State Register on  
 4 November 18, 2020, relating to the Board of Funeral Service Examiners (crematory requirements,  
 5 [6 CSR 02](#)), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Board of Funeral Service Examiners to promulgate a legislative rule relating to crematory requirements.

This section is new; therefore, strike-throughs and underscoring have been omitted.
