- 1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-9-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating
- 2 to authorizing the Board of Hearing Aid Dealers to promulgate a legislative rule relating to
- 3 rule governing the West Virginia Board of Hearing Aid Dealers.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS AGENCIES AND BOARDS TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.

§64-9-1. Board of Hearing Aid Dealers.

- 1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on August 28, 2020, authorized under the
- 2 authority of §30-26-3 of this code, modified by the Board of Hearing Aid Dealers to meet the
- 3 objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and refiled in the State Register on
- 4 December 1, 2020, relating to the Board of Hearing Aid Dealers (rule governing the West Virginia
- 5 Board of Hearing Aid Dealers, 8 CSR 01), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Board of Hearing Aid Dealers to promulgate a legislative rule relating to rule governing the West Virginia Board of Hearing Aid Dealers.
