- 1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-9-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating
- 2 to authorizing the Board of Medicine to promulgate a legislative rule relating to registration
- 3 to practice during declared state of emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS AGENCIES AND BOARDS TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.

§64-9-1. Board of Medicine.

- 1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on June 24, 2020, authorized under the
- 2 authority of §30-3-7 of this code, relating to the Board of Medicine (registration to practice during
- 3 declared state of emergency, 11 CSR 14), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Board of Medicine to promulgate a legislative rule relating to registration to practice during declared state of emergency.
