1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-9-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating
2 to authorizing the Board of Occupational Therapy to promulgate a legislative rule relating
3 to telehealth practice; requirements, definitions.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

**ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS AGENCIES AND BOARDS
TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

§64-9-1. Board of Occupational Therapy.

1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on August 10, 2020, authorized under the
2 authority of §30-28-7 of this code, relating to the Board of Occupational Therapy (telehealth
3 practice; requirements, definitions, [13 CSR 09](#)), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Board of Occupational Therapy to promulgate a legislative rule relating to telehealth practice; requirements, definitions.

This section is new; therefore, strike-throughs and underscoring have been omitted.
