## **Senate Bill 205**

1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-9-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating  
2 to authorizing the Board of Pharmacy to promulgate a legislative rule relating to Board of  
3 Pharmacy rules for immunizations administered by pharmacists and pharmacy interns.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

**ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS AGENCIES AND BOARDS  
TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

**§64-9-1. Board of Pharmacy.**

1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on September 4, 2020, authorized under the  
2 authority of §30-5-7 of this code, modified by the Board of Pharmacy to meet the objections of the  
3 Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and refiled in the State Register on December 2,  
4 2020, relating to the Board of Pharmacy (board of pharmacy rules for immunizations administered  
5 by pharmacists and pharmacy interns, [15 CSR 12](#)), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Board of Pharmacy to promulgate a legislative rule relating to board of pharmacy rules for immunizations administered by pharmacists and pharmacy interns.

This section is new; therefore, strike-throughs and underscoring have been omitted.
