A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new section,
designated §5-2-5, relating to requiring the Secretary of State to create and maintain an
online database of religious organizations; providing effective date; requiring database
contain certain information; and providing for annual update of database.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 2. SECRETARY OF STATE.

§5-2-5. Online database of religious organizations.

- (a) Effective July 1, 2021, the Secretary of State shall create and maintain a database of
 religious organizations within the state.
- 3 (b) The database must be searchable and contain certain information regarding the
 4 religious organization, including the:
- 5 (1) Name; and
- 6 (2) Location or locations;
- 7 (3) Denomination; and
- 8 (4) Times of regular meetings or services that are open to the public.
- 9 (c) The secretary shall modify its forms to seek the information described in subsection (b)
- of this section, and shall update the database on an annual basis, at minimum.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to require the secretary of state to create and maintain a database of public information regarding religious organizations.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from a heading or the present law, and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
