## Senate Bill 36

A BILL to amend and reenact §18-2-25 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating
 to the West Virginia Secondary School Activities Commission; requiring the Legislative
 Auditor to conduct a performance audit of the commission; authorizing the inspection of
 records and examination of personnel; permitting subsequent performance audits be
 conducted at reasonable and prudent intervals; and removing redundant language.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

## **ARTICLE 2. STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION.**

§18-2-25. Authority of county boards to regulate athletic and other extracurricular activities of secondary schools; delegation of authority to West Virginia Secondary School Activities Commission; authority of commission; approval of rules by state board; incorporation; funds <u>and audit of funds;</u> participation by private and parochial schools and by home-schooled students.

(a) The county boards of education shall exercise the control, supervision and regulation
 of all interscholastic athletic events, and other extracurricular activities of the students in public
 secondary schools, and of those schools of their respective counties. The county board of
 education may delegate control, supervision and regulation of interscholastic athletic events and
 band activities to the West Virginia Secondary School Activities Commission.

6 (b) The West Virginia Secondary School Activities Commission is composed of the 7 principals, or their representatives, of those secondary schools whose county boards of education 8 have certified in writing to the State Superintendent of Schools that they have elected to delegate 9 the control, supervision and regulation of their interscholastic athletic events and band activities 10 of the students in the public secondary schools in their respective counties to the commission. 11 The West Virginia Secondary School Activities Commission may exercise the control, supervision 12 and regulation of interscholastic athletic events and band activities of secondary schools, 13 delegated to it pursuant to this section. The rules of the West Virginia Secondary School Activities 14 Commission shall contain a provision for a proper review procedure and review board and be

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promulgated in accordance with the provisions of chapter 29A of this code, but shall, in all instances be subject to the prior approval of the state board. The West Virginia Secondary School Activities Commission, may, with the consent of the State Board of Education, incorporate under the name of West Virginia Secondary School Activities Commission, Inc., as a nonprofit, nonstock corporation under the provisions of chapter 31 of this code.

(c) County boards of education may expend moneys for and pay dues to the West Virginia
 Secondary School Activities Commission, and all moneys paid to the commission, as well as
 moneys derived from any contest or other event sponsored by the commission, are quasi-public
 funds as defined in §18-5-1 *et seq.,* of this code, and the funds of the commission are subject to
 an annual audit by the State Tax Commissioner.

25 (d) In addition, the Legislative Auditor may, at reasonable and prudent intervals, conduct 26 performance audits of the commission. For this purpose, the Legislative Auditor may examine the 27 revenues, expenditures, and performance of the commission, which shall allow the Legislative 28 Auditor to inspect all records and accounts of the commission and to examine the personnel of 29 the commission. For any legally protected information provided or disclosed to the Legislative 30 Auditor pursuant to this subsection, the Legislative Auditor shall protect the confidentiality, 31 privacy, or security of the protected information in like manner and with the same duty as is 32 required of the commission. The Legislative Auditor shall complete an initial performance audit of 33 the commission by December 1, 2022, and, on that date, deliver a report thereof to the Joint Committee on Government and Finance and to the Legislative Oversight Commission on 34 35 Education Accountability.

36 (e) The West Virginia Secondary School Activities Commission shall promulgate 37 reasonable rules providing for the control, supervision and regulation of the interscholastic athletic 38 events and other extracurricular activities of private and parochial secondary schools <del>as</del> <u>that</u> elect 39 to delegate to the commission control, supervision and regulation, upon the same terms and 40 conditions, subject to the same rules and requirements and upon the payment of the same fees

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and charges as those provided for public secondary schools. Any such private or parochial
secondary school shall receive any monetary or other benefits in the same manner and in the
same proportion as any public secondary school.

(f) Notwithstanding any other provision of this section or the commission's rules, the
commission shall consider eligible for participation in interscholastic athletic events and other
extracurricular activities of secondary schools a student who is receiving home instruction
pursuant to §18-8-1(c) of this code and who:

48 (1) Has demonstrated satisfactory evidence of academic progress for one year in
49 compliance with the provisions of that subsection: *Provided*, That the student's average test
50 results are within or above the fourth stanine in all subject areas;

(2) Is enrolled in at least one virtual instructional course per semester, consistent with the
applicable virtual instruction policy of the county board in which the home-schooled student lives
and the State Board;

54 (3) Has not reached the age of 19 by August 1 of the current school year;

55 (4) Is an amateur who receives no compensation, but participates solely for the 56 educational, physical, mental, and social benefits of the activity;

57 (5) Agrees to comply with all disciplinary rules of the West Virginia Secondary School 58 Activities Commission and the county board in which the home-schooled student lives; and

(6) Agrees to obey all rules of the West Virginia Secondary School Activities Commission
governing awards, all-star games, parental consents, physical examinations, and vaccinations
applicable to all high school athletes.

(g) Eligibility is limited to participation in interscholastic athletic events and other extracurricular activities at the public secondary school serving the attendance zone in which the student lives: *Provided*, That home-schooled students who leave a member school during the school year are subject to the same transfer protocols that apply to member-to-member transfers. Reasonable fees may be charged to the student to cover the costs of participation in

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67 interscholastic athletic events and other extracurricular activities.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to require the Legislative Auditor to conduct a performance audit of the West Virginia Secondary School Activities Commission and authorizing the inspection of records and examination of personnel. The bill permits subsequent performance audits to be conducted at reasonable and prudent intervals.
