A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new section, designated §33-16G-10, relating to prohibiting abortion coverage in qualified health care

plans issued or renewed on or after January 1, 2022; and providing an exception to the

4 prohibition when a mother's life is in danger.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

### ARTICLE 16G. WEST VIRGINIA HEALTH BENEFIT EXCHANGE ACT.

#### §33-16G-10. Opt-out of abortion coverage.

- 1 Abortion coverage in qualified health plans offered through the exchange, whether the
- 2 <u>exchange is run solely by the state, in partnership with the federal government or solely by the</u>
- 3 federal government, is prohibited in those plans issued or renewed on or after January 1, 2022:
- 4 Provided, That this does not prohibit coverage of abortion if the mother's life is in danger.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to prohibit abortion coverage in qualified health care plans on or after January 1, 2022, with the exception for coverage when a mother's life is in danger.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from a heading or the present law, and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
