### **Senate Bill 721**

1 A BILL making a supplementary appropriation of public moneys out of the Treasury from the  
 2 balance of moneys remaining unappropriated for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2021, to  
 3 the Department of Environmental Protection, Division of Environmental Protection - Oil  
 4 and Gas Reclamation Fund, fund 3322, fiscal year 2021, organization 0313, by  
 5 supplementing and amending the appropriations for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2021.

1 WHEREAS, The Governor has established that there now remains an unappropriated  
 2 balance in the Department of Environmental Protection, Division of Environmental Protection - Oil  
 3 and Gas Reclamation Fund, fund 3322, fiscal year 2021, organization 0313, that is available for  
 4 expenditure during the fiscal year ending June 30, 2021 which is hereby appropriated by the terms  
 5 of this supplementary appropriation bill; therefore

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

1 That the total appropriation for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2021, to fund 3322, fiscal  
 2 year 2021, organization 0313, be supplemented and amended by increasing existing items of  
 3 appropriation as follows:
