## House Bill 104

By Delegates Hanshaw (Mr. Speaker) and Skaff (By Request of the Executive)

1	A BILL supplementing and amending the appropriations of public moneys out of the Treasury in
2	the State Fund, General Revenue, by decreasing items of appropriation to the Department
3	of Health and Human Resources, Division of Health - Central Office, fund 0407, fiscal
4	year 2022, organization 0506; to the Department of Health and Human Resources,
5	Consolidated Medical Services Fund, fund 0525, fiscal year 2022, organization 0506; to
6	the Department of Homeland Security, Division of Corrections and Rehabilitation – West
7	Virginia Parole Board, fund 0440, fiscal year 2022, organization 0608; to the Department
8	of Homeland Security, Division of Corrections and Rehabilitation - Central Office, fund
9	0446, fiscal year 2022, organization 0608; to the Department of Homeland Security,
10	Division of Corrections and Rehabilitation - Correctional Units, fund 0450, fiscal year
11	2022, organization 0608; to the Department of Homeland Security, Division of Corrections
12	and Rehabilitation – Bureau of Juvenile Services, fund 0570, fiscal year 2022, organization
13	0608; and to the Department of Homeland Security, West Virginia State Police, fund 0453,
14	fiscal year 2022, organization 0612, and by increasing items of appropriation to the
15	Department of Economic Development, Department of Economic Development - Office
16	of the Secretary, fund 0256, fiscal year 2022, organization 0307 for the fiscal year ending
17	June 30, 2022.
18	WHEREAS, The Governor submitted to the Legislature the Executive Budget document,
19	dated February 10, 2021, which included a Statement of the State Fund, General Revenue,
20	setting forth therein the cash balance as of July 1, 2020, and further included an estimate of
21	revenues for the fiscal year 2022 less net appropriation balances forwarded and regular
22	appropriations for the fiscal year 2022; and

WHEREAS, The Governor submitted to the Legislature an Executive Message dated June 24, 2021, which included a revised estimate of revenues for the State Fund, General Revenue and a statement of the State Fund, General Revenue for the fiscal year 2021, and further included

26	an estimate of revenues for the fiscal year 2022 less net appropriation balances forwarded and
27	regular appropriations for the fiscal year 2022; and
28	WHEREAS, The Governor submitted to the Legislature an Executive Message dated
29	January 11, 2022, which included a revised statement of the State Fund, General Revenue for
30	the fiscal year 2022, and further included an estimate of revenues for the fiscal year 2022 less
31	net appropriation balances forwarded and regular appropriations for the fiscal year 2022; and
32	WHEREAS, It appears from the Executive Message dated January 11, 2022, statement
33	of the State Fund, General Revenue and this legislation there remains an unappropriated balance
34	in the State Treasury which is available for appropriation during the fiscal year ending June 30,
35	2022; therefore
36	Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:
