[Passed January 11, 2022; in effect from passage]

1 AN ACT making a supplementary appropriation of federal funds out of the Treasury from the
2 balance of federal moneys remaining unappropriated for the fiscal year ending June 30,
3 2022, to the Executive, Governor’s Office, Coronavirus State Fiscal Recovery Fund, fund
4 8823, fiscal year 2022, organization 0100, by supplementing and amending the
5 appropriations for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2022.

6 WHEREAS, The Governor has established the availability of federal funds for expenditure
7 in the fiscal year ending June 30, 2022 which are hereby appropriated by the terms of this
8 supplementary appropriation bill; therefore

9 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

10 That the total appropriation for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2022, to fund 8823, fiscal
11 year 2022, organization 0100, be supplemented and amended by adding new items of
12 appropriation as follows:
