A BILL to amend and reenact §17E-1-18 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating
to commercial driver's license; and requiring that a state employee with a commercial
driver's license have a current medical evaluation certification and may not have a medical
waiver.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

#### ARTICLE 1. COMMERCIAL DRIVER'S LICENSE.

#### §17E-1-18. Rule-making authority.

- 1 The commissioner shall adopt rules and regulations necessary to carry out the provisions
- 2 of this article: <u>Provided</u>, That the commissioner shall propose rules for legislative approval in
- 3 accordance with §21A-3-1 et seq. of this code that require a state employee with a commercial
- 4 driver's license to have a current medical evaluation certification and that the state employee is
- 5 not entitled to a medical waiver from this requirement.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to require that a state employee with a commercial driver's license have a current medical evaluation certification and may not have a medical waiver.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from a heading or the present law and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
