[Passed February 10, 2022; in effect ninety days from passage.]

1 AN ACT to amend and reenact §17-2A-2 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating
2 to modifying the residency requirement for the Commissioner of the Division of Highways.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 2A. WEST VIRGINIA COMMISSIONER OF HIGHWAYS.

§17-2A-2. Qualifications; office requirements; devotion of full time to duties; supervisory authority; oath; bond.

1 The commissioner shall be a person who is experienced in highway planning, finance,
2 construction, maintenance, management and supervision qualifying him or her for the duties of
3 his or her office; shall devote his or her full time and attention to his or her official duties and
4 responsibilities; shall be a resident of West Virginia; shall maintain his or her office headquarters
5 at the state capital; shall be the chief executive officer of the commission and, subject to other
6 provisions of law, shall have direct and full control, management and supervision of the entire
7 state road program and system; and shall, prior to assumption of the duties of his or her office,
8 take and subscribe to the oath prescribed by the Constitution and execute a bond, with surety
9 approved by the commission, in the penal sum of \$25,000, which executed oath and bond shall
10 be filed with the Secretary of State. Premiums on the commissioner's bond shall be paid from
11 commission funds.
