A BILL to amend and reenact §17-16A-6 of the Code of West Virginia,1931, as amended, relating
 to exempting school buses with students on board from paying turnpike tolls.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 16A. WEST VIRGINIA PARKWAYS, ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT AND TOURISM AUTHORITY.

§17-16A-6. Parkways Authority's powers.

1 (a) The Parkways Authority is hereby authorized and empowered may:

2 (1) <u>To adopt Adopt</u> by laws for the regulation of its affairs and the conduct of its business;

3 (2) To adopt <u>An</u> official seal and alter the same at pleasure;

4 (3) To maintain <u>Maintain</u> an office at such place or places within the state as it may
5 designate;

6 (4) To sue Sue and be sued in its own name, plead and be impleaded. Any and all actions
7 against the Parkways Authority shall be brought only in the county in which the principal office of
8 the Parkways Authority is located;

9 (5) To construct, Construct, reconstruct, improve, maintain, repair, operate or finance 10 projects, at such locations within the state or adjacent to the state pursuant to a reciprocal toll 11 enforcement agreement as may be determined by the Parkways Authority: *Provided*, That after 12 July 1, 2010, the Parkways Authority is prohibited from constructing new tourism projects or new 13 economic development projects, but this prohibition shall may not prevent the authority from 14 entering into lease agreements, development agreements or other agreements with private 15 businesses or companies allowing and providing for such private businesses or companies to 16 acquire, develop, construct and operate motels, lodging facilities or other businesses and 17 business facilities on land owned by the authority and located adjacent to the Tamarack project 18 and facilities at Exit 45 of the West Virginia Turnpike;

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(6) To issue Issue parkway revenue bonds of the State of West Virginia, payable solely

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from toll revenues, for the purpose of paying all or any part of the cost of any one or more parkwayprojects;

(7) To issue Issue parkway revenue refunding bonds of the State of West Virginia, payable
 solely from toll revenues, for any one or more of the following purposes:

24 (A) Refunding any bonds which shall have been issued under the provisions of this article
25 or any predecessor thereof; and

26 (B) Repaying to the state all or any part of the state funds used to upgrade the West
27 Virginia Turnpike to federal interstate standards;

28 (8) To charge Charge, fix and revise, from time to time, tolls or fees for transit over each parkway project constructed or improved or financed by it, by the Department of Transportation 29 or by the West Virginia Turnpike Commission: Provided, That the Parkways Authority may not 30 31 charge tolls or fees for transit over an existing road without express legislative authorization for 32 the charging of such tolls or fees: *Provided, however*. That an existing road does not include the 33 West Virginia Turnpike, new lanes or sections of an existing road, the replacement or construction 34 of any bridge or tunnel, or related facilities: *Provided further*, That no tolls or fees may be charged 35 to school buses with students on board for use of the turnpike;

36 (9) To fix Fix and revise, rents, fees, or other charges, of whatever kind or character, for
37 the use of each tourism project or economic development project constructed by it or for the use
38 of any building, structure or facility constructed by it or financed in connection with a parkway
39 project;

40 (10) To acquire <u>Acquire</u>, hold, lease and dispose of real and personal property in the
41 exercise of its powers and the performance of its duties under this article;

42 (11) To acquire <u>Acquire</u> in the name of the state by purchase or otherwise, on such terms
43 and conditions and in such manner as it may deem <u>consider</u> proper, or by the exercise of the right
44 of condemnation in the manner hereinafter provided, such public or private lands, including public
45 parks, playgrounds or reservations, or parts thereof or rights therein, rights-of-way, property,

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46 rights, easements, and interests, as it may deem <u>consider</u> necessary for carrying out the 47 provisions of this article. No compensation shall <u>may</u> be paid for public lands, playgrounds, parks, 48 parkways or reservations so taken, and all public property damaged in carrying out the powers 49 granted by this article shall be restored or repaired and placed in its original condition as nearly 50 as practicable;

51 (12) To designate <u>Designate</u> the locations of, and establish, limit and control such points 52 of ingress to and egress from, each project as may be necessary or desirable in the judgment of 53 the Parkways Authority to ensure the proper operation and maintenance of such the project and 54 to prohibit entrance to such the project from any point or points not so designated;

(13) To make <u>Make</u> and enter into all contracts and agreements necessary or incidental to the performance of its duties and the execution of its powers under this article, and to employ consulting engineers, attorneys, accountants, architects, construction and financial experts, trustees, superintendents, managers and such other employees and agents as may be necessary in its judgment, and to fix their compensation. All such expenses shall be payable solely from the proceeds of parkway revenue bonds or parkway revenue refunding bonds issued under the provisions of this article or from toll revenues;

62 (14) To make <u>Make</u> and enter into all contracts, agreements or other arrangements with
63 any agency, department, division, board, bureau, commission, authority or other governmental
64 unit of the state to operate, maintain or repair any project;

65 (15) To receive <u>Receive</u> and accept from any federal agency grants for or in aid of the 66 construction of any project, and to receive and accept aid or contributions from any source of 67 either money, property, labor, or other things of value, to be held, used and applied only for the 68 purposes for which such grants and contributions may be made;

(16) To study <u>Study</u>, investigate, evaluate and, if feasible, develop and implement a "single
fee" program the purpose of which is to charge a flat fee to owners of motor vehicles registered
in this state who opt into any such program or any other state which opts into any such program:

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72 Provided, That any single fee program shall apply only to passenger motor vehicles, divided into 73 classes based on size and usage, and shall not apply to commercial motor vehicles. The flat fee 74 shall be set by the authority at a rate or amount so that the aggregate of all toll revenues estimated 75 to be received by the authority at the time of fixing any such rate or amount, or any increase 76 thereof, provides sufficient toll revenues consistent with the purposes set forth in section thirteen 77 of this article and to cover the administrative costs of any such single fee program. The separate 78 fee shall be collected by adding it to the annual cost of vehicle registration as an additional fee 79 payable solely to the authority pursuant to §17A-10-17 of this code. A registered motor vehicle for 80 which such the single program fee has been paid shall be entitled to traverse all toll roads within 81 the state without stopping to pay individual tolls during the effective period of said vehicle 82 registration. The single fee program may also include comparable provisions which would allow 83 vehicles registered in other states to traverse West Virginia toll roads in like fashion to West 84 Virginia vehicles as set forth in this section upon the payment of a single fee for each and every 85 vehicle registered in such the state, in accordance with the same classification system adopted 86 for West Virginia vehicles. The Parkways Authority, in consultation with the Division of Motor 87 Vehicles, shall propose rules for legislative approval in accordance with the provisions of §29A-88 3-1 et seq. of this code to implement any single fee program under this subdivision (16);

(17) To enter Enter into reciprocal toll enforcement agreements with other toll agencies in
 this state or in any other state or foreign country;

91 (18) To do Do all acts and things necessary or convenient to carry out the powers
92 expressly granted in this article; and

93 (19) To file File the necessary petition or petitions pursuant to federal bankruptcy laws.
94 The State of West Virginia hereby consents to the application of Title 11 of the United States Code
95 to the Parkways Authority.

96 (b) Nothing in this article shall <u>may</u> be construed to prohibit the issuance of parkway 97 revenue refunding bonds in a common plan of financing with the issuance of parkway revenue

98 bonds.
