1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-5-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating
 2 to authorizing the Department of Health and Human Resources to promulgate a legislative
 3 rule relating to Childhood Lead Screening.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

**ARTICLE 5. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN
 RESOURCES TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

§64-5-1. Department of Health and Human Resources

1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 30, 2021, authorized under the
 2 authority of §16-35-4 of this code, modified by the Department of Health and Human Resources
 3 to meet the objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and refiled in the State
 4 Register on September 24, 2021, relating to the Department of Health and Human Resources
 5 (Childhood Lead Screening, [64 CSR 42](#)), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Department of Health and Human Resources to promulgate a legislative rule relating to Childhood Lead Screening.
