1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-6-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating
 2 to authorizing the State Police to promulgate a legislative rule relating to Career
 3 Progression.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

**ARTICLE 6. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY TO
 PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

§64-6-1. State Police.

1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 30, 2021, authorized under the
 2 authority of §15-2-5 of this code, modified by the State Police to meet the objections of the
 3 Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and refiled in the State Register on January 10, 2022,
 4 relating to the State Police (Career Progression , [81 CSR 03](#)), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the State Police to promulgate a legislative rule relating to Career Progression.
