Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANOUS AGENCIES AND BOARDS TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.

§64-9-1. Board of Medicine

- The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 30, 2021, authorized under the authority of §30-3-7 of this code, modified by the Board of Medicine to meet the objections of the
- 3 Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and refiled in the State Register on October 25, 2021.
- 4 relating to the Board of Medicine (Establishment and Regulation of Limited License to Practice
- 5 Medicine and Surgery at Certain State Veterans Nursing Home Facilities, 11 CSR 11), is
- 6 authorized.
