- 1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-10-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating
- to authorizing the Office of Miners' Health, Safety and Training to promulgate a legislative
- 3 rule relating to Substance Abuse Screening, Standards and Procedures.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 10. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.

§64-10-1. Miners' Health, Safety and Training.

- 1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 30, 2021, authorized under the
- 2 authority of §22A-1A-2 of this code, modified by the Office of Miners' Health, Safety and Training
- 3 to meet the objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and refiled in the State
- 4 Register on August 24, 2021, relating to the Office Miners' Health, Safety and Training (Substance
- 5 Abuse Screening, Standards and Procedures, 56 CSR 19), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Office of Miners' Health, Safety and Training to promulgate a legislative rule relating to Substance Abuse Screening, Standards and Procedures.
