A BILL amend and reenact §30-5-11a and §30-5-26 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as
 amended, all relating to the practice of pharmacist care; relating to the qualifications for
 pharmacy technician trainees; requiring certain information to be included on a
 prescription; and requiring a prescription change be communicated to a pharmacist.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 5. PHARMACISTS, PHARMACY TECHNICIANS, PHARMACY INTERNS AND PHARMACIES.

§30-5-11a. Pharmacy technician trainee qualifications.

- (a) To be eligible for registration as a pharmacy technician trainee to assist in the practice
 of pharmacist care, the applicant shall:
- 3 (1) Submit a written application to the board;
- 4 (2) Pay the applicable fees;
- 5 (3) (A) Have graduated from a high school or obtained a Certificate of General Educational
 6 Development (GED), Be at least 16 years old and currently enrolled in high school; or
- bevelopment (GED), be at least 10 years out and currently enrolled in high school, or
- 7 (B) Be currently enrolled in a high school competency based pharmacy technician
- 8 education and training program;
- 9 (4) (A) Be currently enrolled in a competency-based pharmacy technician education and
 10 training program of a learning institution or training center approved by the board; or
- (B) Be an employee of a pharmacy in an on-the-job competency-based pharmacytechnician training program.
- (5) Not be an alcohol or drug abuser as these terms are defined in §27-1A-11 of this code: *Provided*, That an applicant in an active recovery process, which may, in the discretion of the
 board, be evidenced by participation in a twelve-step program or other similar group or process,
 may be considered;
- 17 (6) Not have been convicted of a felony in any jurisdiction within ten years preceding the
 18 date of application for registration, which conviction remains unreversed;

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(7) Not have been convicted of a misdemeanor or felony in any jurisdiction which bears a
 rational nexus to the practice of pharmacist care, which conviction remains unreversed; and

(8) Have requested and submitted to the board the results of a fingerprint-based state and
a national electronic criminal history records check.

23 (b) A person may be employed as a pharmacy trainee technician in an on-the-job

24 <u>competency-based technician training program immediately upon submission of an application</u>

25 and payment of the applicable fees to the board, for up to 90 days prior to being registered as a

26 pharmacy technician trainee by the board.

(b) (c) The rules, authorized duties and unauthorized prohibitions as set out in §30-5-12
 of this code for pharmacy technicians apply to pharmacy technician trainees.

(c) (d) The board shall promulgate an emergency rule and legislative rule pursuant §29A 2-1 *et seq.* of this code to authorize the requirements of this section to permit pharmacy technician
 trainees.

§30-5-26. Filling of prescriptions more than one year after issuance.

1 (a) A prescription order may not be dispensed after twelve months from the date of 2 issuance by the practitioner. A pharmacist may fill the prescription after twelve months if the 3 prescriber confirms to the pharmacist that he or she still wants the prescription filled and the 4 pharmacist documents upon the prescription that the confirmation was obtained.

5 (b) (1) When a person licensed under this chapter issues a prescription for any medication
6 or durable medical equipment, the IDC-10 code or any other equivalent diagnosis code's shall be
7 submitted on the prescription.

8 (2) If a person licensed under this chapter changes to the dosage, frequency, or manner
 9 of administration of a medication, the licensee shall, within 72 hours of that change inform the
 10 patient's pharmacy of the change.

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
