- 1 A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new section,
- designated §15-2-56, relating to authorizing the superintendent to administer the Handle
- with Care program.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 2. WEST VIRGINIA STATE POLICE.

§15-2-56. Handle with Care program.

- 1 (a) The purpose of this section is to ensure that the State Police, through its West Virginia
- 2 Center for Children's Justice, oversee and administer the state's Handle with Care program.
- 3 <u>(b) The superintendent shall:</u>
- 4 (1) Direct and oversee the administration and implementation of the state's Handle with
- 5 Care program;
- 6 (2) Employ one or more persons deemed necessary to administer the program;
- 7 (3) Establish and coordinate education and training of law enforcement and other parties
- 8 <u>considered necessary for implementation of the program;</u>
- 9 (4) Apply for grant funding necessary to support the administration and implementation of
- 10 the program; and
- 11 (5) Accept and expend grants, gifts, beguests, donations, and other funds from any source
- 12 <u>to ensure that the State Police can accomplish the mission of the program.</u>
- 13 (c) Nothing herein shall require that the Legislature appropriate funds to accomplish the
- 14 purpose of this section.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the superintendent of the State Police to oversee the administration and implementation of the state's Handle with Care program.
