1 A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new section,

designated §61-1-10, relating to creating the misdemeanor criminal offense of filing a false

3 complaint against a law-enforcement official; and providing a penalty.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 1. CRIMES AGAINST THE GOVERNMENT.

§61-1-10. Filing false complaint against law-enforcement official; penalty.

1 Any person who knowingly files a false complaint against a law-enforcement officer or law-

enforcement official that results in an investigation, is guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon

conviction thereof, shall be fined not less than \$100 nor more than \$1,000, or confined in jail for

4 not more than six months, or both fined and confined.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to create a misdemeanor criminal offense of filing a false complaint against a law-enforcement official.
