- 1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-5-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating
- 2 to authorizing the Department of Health and Human Resources to promulgate a legislative
- 3 rule relating to medication-assisted treatment—opioid treatment programs.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

# ARTICLE 5. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN RESOURCES TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.

#### §64-5-1. Department of Health and Human Resources.

- 1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on May 10, 2021, authorized under the
- 2 authority of §16-5Y-13 of this code, relating to the Department of Health and Human Resources
- 3 (Medication-Assisted Treatment Opioid Treatment Programs, 69 CSR 11), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Department of Health and Human Resources to promulgate a legislative rule relating to Medication-Assisted Treatment - Opioid Treatment Programs.
