1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-6-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating
 2 to authorizing the Governor’s Committee on Crime, Delinquency, and Correction to
 3 promulgate a legislative rule relating to law—enforcement training and certification
 4 standards.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

**ARTICLE 6. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY TO
 PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

§64-6-1. Crime, Delinquency and Correction.

1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 29, 2021, authorized under the
 2 authority of §30-29-3 of this code, modified by the Governor’s Committee Crime, Delinquency and
 3 Correction to meet the objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and refiled
 4 in the State Register on September 23, 2021, relating to the Governor’s Committee Crime,
 5 Delinquency and Correction (Law Enforcement Training and Certification Standards, [149 CSR](#)
 6 [02](#)), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Governor’s Committee Crime, Delinquency and Correction to promulgate a legislative rule relating to Law Enforcement Training and Certification Standards.

This section is new; therefore, strike-throughs and underscoring have been omitted.
