- 2 to authorizing the Board of Pharmacy to promulgate a legislative rule relating to the

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

### ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANOUS AGENCIES AND BOARDS TO

### PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.

#### §64-9-1. Board of Pharmacy.

1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 21, 2021, authorized under the 2 authority of §60A-9-6 of this code, modified by the Board of Pharmacy to meet the objections of 3 the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and refiled in the State Register on September 4 28, 2021, relating to the Board of Pharmacy (Controlled Substances Monitoring Program, 15 5 CSR 08), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Board of Pharmacy to promulgate a legislative rule relating to the Controlled Substances Monitoring Program.

This section is new; therefore, strike-throughs and underscoring have been omitted.
