## **Senate Bill 379**

1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-9-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating  
2 to authorizing the Public Service Commission to promulgate a legislative rule relating to  
3 the occupancy of customer-provided conduit.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

**ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS AGENCIES AND BOARDS TO  
PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

**§64-9-1. Public Service Commission.**

1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on August 6, 2021, authorized under the  
2 authority of §24-2E-3 of this code, modified by the Public Service Commission to meet the  
3 objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and refiled in the State Register on  
4 August 24, 2021, relating to the Public Service Commission (Rules Governing the Occupancy of  
5 Customer-Provided Conduit, [150 CSR 37](#)), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Public Service Commission to promulgate a legislative rule relating to Rules Governing the Occupancy of Customer-Provided Conduit.

This section is new; therefore, strike-throughs and underscoring have been omitted.
