Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

# ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANOUS AGENCIES AND BOARDS TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.

#### §64-9-1. Board of Registered Professional Nurses.

- 1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on August 31, 2021, authorized under the
- 2 authority of §30-7-4 of this code, relating to the Board of Registered Professional Nurses
- 3 (Telehealth Practice, 19 CSR 16), is authorized with the amendment set forth below:
- 4 On page 7, subsection 7.4, after the words, "standard of care" by inserting the words,
- 5 "with respect to an established patient".

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Board of Registered Professional Nurses to promulgate a legislative rule relating to Telehealth Practice.

This section is new; therefore, strike-throughs and underscoring have been omitted.
