## **Senate Bill 392**

1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-9-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating  
2 to authorizing the Board of Social Work Examiners to promulgate a legislative rule relating  
3 to qualifications for the profession of social work.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

**ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS AGENCIES AND BOARDS TO  
PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

**§64-9-1. Social Work Examiners.**

1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 30, 2021, authorized under the  
2 authority of §30-30-6 of this code, modified by the Board of Social Work Examiners to meet the  
3 objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and refiled in the State Register on  
4 December 20, 2021, relating to the Board of Social Work Examiners (Qualifications for the  
5 Profession of Social Work, [25 CSR 01](#)), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Board Social Work Examiners to promulgate a legislative rule relating to Qualifications for the Profession of Social Work.

This section is new; therefore, strike-throughs and underscoring have been omitted.
