1	Whereas, The Governor submitted the Executive Budget Document to the Legislature on					
2	January 12, 2022, containing a Statement of the State Fund, General Revenue, setting forth					
3	3 therein the cash balance as of July 1, 2021, and further included the revised estimate of revenue					
4	4 for the fiscal year 2022, less net appropriation balances forwarded and regular and surplus					
5	appropriations for the fiscal year 2022; and					
6	Whereas, It appears from the Governor's Statement of the State Fund, General Revenue,					
7	7 there now remains an unappropriated balance in the Treasury which is available for appropriation					
8	during the fiscal year ending June 30, 2022; therefore
