- 1 A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, by adding thereto a new section, designated
- 2 §18-2-44, relating to the removal of standardized testing in public and private schools; and
- 3 providing for an effective date.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 2. STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION.

§18-2-44. Removal of standardized testing in schools.

- 1 (a) The State Board of Education shall cease the administration of all standardized tests
- 2 and testing in public and private schools.
- 3 (b) This section shall become effective for the 2023-2024 school year and for every school
- 4 year thereafter.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to eliminate standardized testing requirements in West Virginia public and private schools.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from a heading or the present law and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
