- A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new section,
 designated §33-16I-10, relating to prohibiting abortion coverage in qualified health care
 plans issued or renewed on or after January 1, 2024; and providing an exception to the
- 4 prohibition when a mother's life is in danger.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 16I. WEST VIRGINIA HEALTH BENEFIT EXCHANGE ACT.

§33-16I-10. Opt-out of abortion coverage.

- 1 Abortion coverage in qualified health plans offered through the exchange, whether the
- 2 <u>exchange is run solely by the state, in partnership with the federal government or solely by the</u>
- 3 <u>federal government, is prohibited in those plans issued or renewed on or after January 1, 2024:</u>
- 4 *Provided*, That this does not prohibit coverage of abortion if the mother's life is in danger.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to prohibit abortion coverage in qualified health care plans on or after January 1, 2024, with the exception for coverage when a mother's life is in danger.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from a heading or the present law and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
