- A BILL to amend and reenact §3-5-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to
 changing the time of holding primary elections in this state to the second Tuesday in
- 3 August 2024, and in each second year thereafter.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 5. PRIMARY ELECTIONS AND NOMINATING PROCEDURES.

§3-5-1. Time and place of holding primary elections in the year one thousand nine hundred

eighty and thereafter; hours polls open.

- 1 Primary elections shall be held at the voting place in each of the voting precincts in the
- 2 state, for the purposes set forth in this article, on the second Tuesday in May 1986 August 2024
- 3 and in each second year thereafter.
- 4 At such election the polls shall be opened and closed at the hours provided for opening and
- 5 closing the polls in a general election.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to change the time of holding primary elections to the second Tuesday in August, 2024, and in each second year thereafter.
