- A BILL to amend and reenact §64-9-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to
- 2 authorizing the Board of Funeral Service Examiners to promulgate a legislative rule
- 3 relating to crematory requirements.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF MISCELLANEOUS AGENCIES AND BOARDS TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.

§64-9-1. Board of Funeral Service Examiners.

- The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 27, 2022, authorized under the
- 2 authority of §30-6-6 of this code, modified by the Board of Funeral Service Examiners to meet the
- 3 objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and refiled in the State Register on
- 4 October 4, 2022, relating to the Board of Funeral Service Examiners (crematory requirements, 6
- 5 CSR 02), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Board of Funeral Service Examiners to promulgate a legislative rule relating to crematory requirements.
