- 2 authorizing the Board of Registered Nurses to promulgate a legislative rule relating to fees
- 3 for services rendered by the board.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

# ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF MISCELLANEOUS AGENCIES AND BOARDS TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.

#### §64-9-1. Board of Registered Nurses.

- The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 26, 2022, authorized under the
- 2 authority of §30-7-4 of this code, modified by the Board of Registered Nurses to meet the
- 3 objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and refiled in the State Register on
- 4 November 10, 2022, relating to the Board of Registered Nurses (fees for services rendered by the
- 5 board, 19 CSR 12), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Board of Registered Nurses to promulgate a legislative rule relating to fees for services rendered by the board.
