1 A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new article, 2 designated §16-2Q-1, relating to requiring physicians to notify parents when prescribing 3 contraceptives to minors; and providing definitions. Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia: ARTICLE 2Q. PARENTAL NOTIFICATION OF PRESCRIBED CONTRACEPTIVES. Contraceptives; parental §16-2Q-1. notice; definitions. 1 (a) A physician located within this state shall provide parental notification when prescribing 2 a contraceptive to a minor. 3 (b) For the purposes of this section: 4 "Contraceptive" means a drug or device approved by the food and drug administration to 5 prevent pregnancy. 6 "Minor" means a person under the age of 18 years who has not graduated from high
