1 A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new section, designated §5-5-7; to amend said code by adding thereto a new section, designated §15-2 3 2-5a; and to amend said code by adding thereto a new section, designated §18A-4-5c, all 4 relating to mandating executive branch agencies, State Police, and county boards of 5 education develop and report an area market rate salary adjustment policy; stating 6 findings; directing state agencies, State Police, and county boards of education develop 7 and report an area market rate salary adjustment policy by certain date; establishing 8 mandatory terms to be included in policy; and providing that no private cause of action or 9 right to grievance arises from operation of the policy.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

CHAPTER 5. GENERAL POWERS AND AUTHORITY OF THE GOVERNOR, SECRETARY OF STATE, AND ATTORNEY GENERAL; BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS; MISCELLANEOUS AGENCIES, COMMISSIONS, OFFICES, PROGRAMS, ETC.

ARTICLE 5. SALARY INCREASE FOR STATE EMPLOYEES.

§5-5-7. Mandatory area market rate salary adjustment program; required provisions.

- 1 (a) The Legislature finds that:
- 2 (1) Certain areas of the state are experiencing higher economic growth and more rapid
- 3 increases in the costs of living when compared with other areas of the state;
- 4 (2) The state is losing valuable public employees in these areas because salaries and
- 5 benefits are not competitive with the salaries and benefits paid to employees of other entities,
- 6 including other state governments, the federal government, and private employers; and
- 7 (3) Salary adjustments are necessary and prudent to ensure all employees have a
- 8 <u>standard of living that is uniform throughout the state.</u>

9 (b) The Legislature hereby directs that all executive branch state agencies develop an

10 area market rate salary adjustment policy no later than July 1, 2025.

- 11 (c) Every area market rate salary adjustment policy shall, at a minimum, include:
- 12 (1) Criteria for the executive head of the agency to designate counties or areas within
- 13 counties to which any area market rate salary adjustment shall apply:
- 14 (2) Designation of the amount or range of increases that may be granted pursuant to the
- 15 policy and the positions to which the increases may apply;
- 16 (3) Provisions that the policy may not be construed to prohibit other pay increases based
- 17 on merit, seniority, promotion, or other reason, and further providing that any increase in
- 18 compensation pursuant to the area market rate salary adjustment policy shall be granted prior to
- 19 <u>consideration of any other increases:</u>
- 20 (4) Provisions that the policy may be applied to positions regardless of classification or
- 21 <u>title;</u>
- 22 (5) Provisions that if, following an increase in salary pursuant to the policy, an employee
- 23 will make more than the maximum allowable range established for the position classification by

24 <u>statute, statutory schedule, or the West Virginia Division of Personnel, the increase shall still take</u>

- 25 effect and the employee shall make more than the pay grade or classification maximum;
- 26 (6) Provisions for reduction or termination of any increase in an employee's salary if the
- 27 <u>employee no longer qualifies for an increase under the terms of the policy;</u>
- 28 (7) Provisions that the policy may not be construed to mandate an increase in the salary
- 29 of any elected or appointed officer of the state;
- 30 (8) Provisions that no right to grievance or private cause of action, either express or
- 31 implied, is created, may be inferred, or otherwise may arise from the provisions or enactment of
- 32 the policy; and
- 33 (9) Provisions that the policy shall be reviewed and updated annually.

- 34 (d) The policy mandated by this section shall be provided to the President of the Senate,
- 35 the Speaker of the House of Delegates, the Governor's Office, and the State Budget Office in
- 36 writing and electronically no later than September 1, 2023.
- 37 (e) It is the specific intent of the Legislature that no right to grievance or private cause of
- 38 action, either express or implied, is created or otherwise may arise from the provisions of this
- 39 <u>section.</u>

CHAPTER 15. PUBLIC SAFETY.

ARTICLE 2. WEST VIRGINIA STATE POLICE.

§15-2-5a. Mandatory area market rate salary adjustment policy; required provisions.

- 1 The superintendent shall develop and report an area market rate salary adjustment policy
- 2 in accordance with the provisions of §5-5-7 of this code.

CHAPTER 18A. SCHOOL PERSONNEL.

ARTICLE 4. SALARIES, WAGES, AND OTHER BENEFITS.

§18A-4-5c. Mandatory area market rate salary adjustment policy; required provisions.

- 1 Each county board of education shall develop and report an area market rate salary
- 2 adjustment policy in accordance with the provisions of §5-5-7 of this code for professional and
- 3 <u>service personnel.</u>
