| | ARTICLE 3. WEST VIRGINIA MEDICAL PRACTICE ACT. | | |
| | §30-3-12a. Emeritus physician licenses; rulemaking. | | |
| 1 | (a) In acknowledgement of the important service physicians, podiatric physicians, and | | |
| 2 | physician assistants provide to the citizens of West Virginia, the board is authorized to issue, | | |
| 3 | without a fee, an emeritus license to a provider who was previously licensed by the board and | | |
| 4 | who has fully retired from clinical professional practice if the provider was actively practicing in | | |
| 5 | good standing in this state for a minimum of 10 consecutive years immediately preceding the | | |
| 6 | provider's retirement. | | |
| 7 | (b) An emeritus license is an honorific license and does not authorize the holder to practice | | |
| 8 | any profession in this state or engage in any clinical practice whatsoever. | | |
| 9 | (c) An emeritus license may not be converted to a license to practice the holder's | | |
| 10 | profession. Emeritus licensees who seek to return to active clinical practice must apply to | | |
| 11 | reactivate licensure and meet all the requirements for reactivation, including any continuing | | |
| 12 | education requirements. | | |
| 13 | (d) An emeritus license shall be valid for the life of the holder, without periodic renewal, | | |
| 14 | unless the holder returns to active clinical practice, or the board revokes the license. | | |
| 15 | (e) The board shall promulgate rules for legislative approval in accordance with the | | |
