1 A BILL supplementing and amending the appropriations of public moneys out of the Treasury from
 2 the balance of moneys remaining as an unappropriated balance in the State Fund, General
 3 Revenue, to the Department of Health, Department of Health – Central Office, fund 0407,
 4 fiscal year 2025, organization 0506, Office of the Inspector General, fund 0437, fiscal year
 5 2025, organization 0513, Department of Health, Consolidated Medical Services Fund,
 6 fund 0525, fiscal year 2025, organization 0506, Department of Human Services, Division
 7 of Human Services, fund 0403, fiscal year 2025, organization 0511, by supplementing and
 8 amending the appropriations for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2025, by adding new items
 9 of _____ appropriation.

1 WHEREAS, The Governor submitted the Executive Budget Document to the Legislature
 2 on January 10, 2024, containing a statement of the State Fund, General Revenue, setting forth
 3 therein the cash balance as of July 1, 2023, and further included the estimate of revenue for the
 4 fiscal year 2025, less net appropriation balances forwarded and regular appropriations for the
 5 fiscal _____ year _____ 2025;

1 WHEREAS, The Governor submitted to the Legislature an Executive Message dated May
 2 19, 2024, and included a Statement of the State Fund, General Revenue, for the fiscal year 2025;
 3 and

1 WHEREAS, It appears from the Statement of the State Fund, General Revenue, there
 2 remains an unappropriated balance in the State Treasury which is available for appropriation
 3 during the fiscal year ending June 30, 2025; therefore

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

1 That Chapter 11, Acts of the Legislature, Regular Session, 2024, known as the budget bill,
 2 fund 0407, fiscal year 2025, organization 0506, be supplemented and amended to read as follows:

14 Any unexpended balances remaining in the appropriations for Capital Outlay and
15 Maintenance (fund 0407, appropriation 75500), Emergency Response Entities – Special
16 Projects (fund 0407, appropriation 82200), Tobacco Education Program (fund 0407,
17 appropriation 90600), and Pregnancy Centers – Surplus (fund 0407, appropriation 49999) at the
18 close of the fiscal year 2024 are hereby reappropriated for expenditure during the fiscal year
19 2025.

20 Any unexpended balances remaining in the appropriation Chief Medical Examiner (fund
21 0407, appropriation 04500) at the close of fiscal year 2024 shall be transferred to Chief Medical
22 Examiner appropriation (fund 0432, appropriation 04500).

23 Any unexpended balances remaining in the appropriation Safe Drinking Water Program
24 (fund 0407, appropriation 18700) at the close of fiscal year 2024 shall be transferred to
25 Environmental Health Services appropriation (fund 0417, appropriation 30002).

26 Any unexpected balances remaining in the appropriation Statewide EMS Program
27 Support (fund 0407, appropriation 38300) at the close of fiscal year 2024 shall be transferred to
28 Statewide EMS Program Support appropriation (fund 0434, appropriation 38300).

29 Any unexpended balances remaining in the appropriation Office of Medical Cannabis
30 (fund 0407, appropriation 42001) at the close of fiscal year 2024 shall be transferred to Office of
31 Medical Cannabis appropriation (fund 0427, appropriation 42001).

32 Any unexpended balances remaining in the appropriation Office of Medical Cannabis –
33 Surplus (fund 0407, appropriation 42099) at the close of fiscal year 2024 shall be transferred to
34 Office of Medical Cannabis – Surplus appropriation (fund 0427, appropriation 42099).

35 Any unexpended balances remaining in the appropriation Vaccine for Children (fund
36 0407, appropriation 55100) at the close of fiscal year 2024 shall be transferred to Vaccine for
37 Children appropriation (fund 0418, appropriation 55100).

38 Any unexpended balances remaining in the appropriation Maternal and Child Health
39 Clinics, Clinicians and Medical Contracts and Fees (fund 0407, appropriation 57500) at the
40 close of fiscal year 2024 shall be transferred to the Maternal and Child Health Clinics, Clinicians
41 and Medical Contracts and Fees appropriation (fund 0405, appropriation 57500).

42 Any unexpended balances remaining in the appropriations Office of Drug Control Policy
43 (fund 0407, appropriation 35401) at the close of fiscal year 2024 shall be transferred to Office of
44 Drug Control Policy (fund 0403, appropriation 35401).

45 Any unexpended balances remaining in the appropriations Office of Drug Control Policy
46 – Surplus (fund 0407, appropriation 35402) at the close of fiscal year 2024 shall be transferred
47 to Office of Drug Control Policy – Surplus (fund 0403, appropriation 35402).

48 Notwithstanding the provisions of Title I, section three of this bill, the Secretary of the
49 Department of Health shall have the authority to transfer funds within the above appropriations:
50 *Provided*, That no more than five percent of the funds appropriated to one appropriation may be
51 transferred to other appropriations: *Provided, however*, That no funds from other appropriations

52 shall be transferred to the Personal Services and Employee Benefits appropriation: *Provided,*
53 *further, notwithstanding the above,* that for Fiscal Year 2025 the Secretary of the Department of
54 Health shall have additional authority to transfer appropriations between Personal Services and
55 Employee Benefits and other dedicated appropriations within the respective departments to
56 effectuate the 5% average salary increases granted during the 2024 regular legislative session:
57 *Provided, further, notwithstanding the above,* that for Fiscal Year 2025 the Secretary of Health
58 shall have the authority to make transfers from the Department of Health Reserve (fund 0407,
59 appropriation XXXXX) appropriation to any general revenue funds under the department. The
60 Secretary shall submit a monthly report to the Joint Committee on Government and Finance
61 beginning on August 1, 2024 on transfers made from the Department of Health Reserve
62 appropriation. The report shall provide an individual accounting on each transfer of funds out of
63 the Department of Health Reserve appropriation, including the fund and appropriation to which
64 the transfer was made and a detailed explanation of the need for the transfer. At the request of
65 the co-chairs, the report shall be presented in person to the Joint Committee on Government
66 and Finance.

67 Any unexpended balance remaining in the appropriation Department of Health Reserve
68 (fund 0407, appropriation XXXXX) as of March 31, 2025 shall revert to the unappropriated
69 surplus balance of General Revenue.

70 And, That Chapter 11, Acts of the Legislature, Regular Session, 2024, known as the
71 budget bill, fund 0437, fiscal year 2025, organization 0513, be supplemented and amended to
72 read as follows:

6 \$73,065 shall be used for informal dispute resolution relating to nursing home administrative
7 appeals and \$650,000 shall be transferred to OIG fund 5209.

8 And, That Chapter 11, Acts of the Legislature, Regular Session, 2024, known as the
9 budget bill, to fund 0525, fiscal year 2025, organization 0506, be supplemented and amended to
10 add a new item of appropriation:

52 Any unexpended balances remaining in the appropriations for Behavioral Health
 53 Program (fund 0403, appropriation 21900), Substance Abuse Continuum of Care (fund 0403,
 54 appropriation 35400), Office of Drug Control Policy (fund 0403, appropriation 35401), Capital
 55 Outlay and Maintenance (fund 0403, appropriation 75500), Indigent Burials (fund 0403,
 56 appropriation 85100), and Office of Drug Control Policy – Surplus (fund 0403, appropriation
 57 35402) at the close of the fiscal year 2024 are hereby reappropriated for expenditure during the
 58 fiscal year 2025.

59 Notwithstanding the provisions of Title I, section three of this bill, the Secretary of the
 60 Department of Human Services shall have the authority to transfer funds within the above
 61 appropriations: *Provided*, That no more than five percent of the funds appropriated to one
 62 appropriation may be transferred to other appropriations: *Provided, however*, That no funds
 63 from other appropriations shall be transferred to the Personal Services and Employee Benefits
 64 appropriation: *Provided, further, notwithstanding the above*, that for Fiscal Year 2025 the
 65 Secretary of the Department of Human Services shall have additional authority to transfer
 66 appropriations between Personal Services and Employee Benefits and other dedicated
 67 appropriations within the respective departments to effectuate the 5% average salary increases
 68 granted during the 2024 regular legislative session: *Provided, further, notwithstanding the*
 69 *above*, that for Fiscal Year 2025 the Secretary of Human Services shall have the authority to
 70 make transfers from the Department of Human Services Reserve (fund 0403, appropriation

71 XXXXX) appropriation to any general revenue funds under the department. The Secretary shall
72 submit monthly report to the Joint Committee on Government and Finance beginning on August
73 1, 2024 on transfers made from the Department of Human Services Reserve appropriation. The
74 report shall provide an individual accounting on each transfer of funds out of the Department of
75 Human Services appropriation, including the fund and appropriation to which the transfer was
76 made and a detailed explanation of the need for the transfer. At the request of the co-chairs, the
77 report shall be presented in person to the Joint Committee on Government and Finance.

78 The Secretary shall have authority to expend funds for the educational costs of those
79 children residing in out-of-state placements, excluding the costs of special education programs.

80 Any unexpended balance remaining in the appropriation Department of Human Services
81 Reserve (fund 0403, appropriation XXXXX) as of March 31, 2025 shall revert to the
82 unappropriated surplus balance of General Revenue.

83 The above appropriation for James "Tiger" Morton Catastrophic Illness Fund (fund 0403,
84 appropriation 45500) shall be transferred to the James "Tiger" Morton Catastrophic Illness Fund
85 (fund 5454) as provided by Article 5Q, Chapter 16 of the W.V. Code.

86 The above appropriation for WV Works Separate State Program (fund 0403,
87 appropriation 69800) shall be transferred to the WV Works Separate State College Program
88 Fund (fund 5467) and the WV Works Separate State Two-Parent Program Fund (fund 5468) as
89 determined by the Secretary of the Department of Human Services.

90 From the above appropriation for Child Support Enforcement (fund 0403, appropriation
91 70500), an amount not to exceed \$300,000 may be transferred to a local banking depository to
92 be utilized to offset funds determined to be uncollectible.

93 Included in the appropriation for Behavioral Health Program (fund 0403, appropriation
94 21900), is \$100,000 for Recovery Point of Huntington.

95 The above appropriation for Children's Trust Fund – Transfer (fund 0403, appropriation
96 95100) shall be transferred to the Children's Trust Fund (fund 5469).

97 From the above appropriation for Substance Abuse Continuum of Care (fund 0403,
98 appropriation 35400), the funding will be consistent with the goal areas outlined in the
99 Comprehensive Substance Abuse Strategic Action Plan.
